6. Method of selecting sample

Caliger said "Sample is a component of sample is such a part of field which represent the whole worth field" Lerner has selected four B.Ed. college randomly from all B.Ed. colleges of surat keeping in mind time and energy of the field.

In this study, out of 32 B.Ed. colleges of South Gujarat University, Surat, 9 B.Ed. colleges were selected randomly and from them 300 students studying in 4 B.Ed. Colleges were selected.

7. Research Tools

There are so many field covered under research so it is not feasible to use only one tool for collecting data from all the field because different tools provide different type of information so for collecting appropriate data related tool should be selected. Tools of questionnaire, personal visit, rating scale, was used in this research.

8. Tools acquired

For collecting information from trainee learner has constructed five point rating scale. Required correction was done after getting feedback from expert and final shape was given thereafter. Trainees have to give their feedback by putting tick mark.

9. Method of data collection

Learner has made pre-plan for collecting information. For collecting information learner has taken the permission of principal and had visited personally professors at trainees for collecting information.

10. Data analysis

For analyzing the collected information various statistical techniques are available. But as the present study is related to survey method X^2 method is used for analyzing the data.
