3. Effectiveness of Using Multimedia in Classroom

In order to access the effectiveness of multimedia the researchers had conducted a small survey among the teachers and the students of S. S. PATEL SCIENE AND COMMERCE COLLEGE AT VISNAGAR. The faculty members of Department of Communication Skills teach professional communication to 1st and 3rd S semester students and they usually employ audio visual techniques and material to teach language and soft skills to the Science students. Therefore, interviews were conducted where few faculty members and students were asked to give their point of view regarding use of multimedia in classroom.

4. Students Perspective

34 Students of semester 1^{st} and 3^{rd} were interviewed and asked the following question. The responses are also given below

Q) Do you prefer learning language or soft skills through multimedia?

• Majority of the students answered that they preferred learning language or soft skills through multimedia because it gives them a new method of learning apart from text book learning.

Q) Is Using Multimedia in classroom beneficial in learning process?

The following are the general responses of the students

- When multimedia techniques are used in the class it helps to understand and connect ourselves to the content easily and quickly as we can visualize the situation instead of imagining.
- Usage of video clips based on the content with real life examples helps to manage and tackle situations faced in personal and professional life.
- Learning professional communication through multimedia changes the entire atmosphere in the classroom making learning more interesting and interactive.
- Teaching through chalk and talk method sometimes brings boredom among the students but on other hand if audio visual aids like presentations and video clips are used it has a positive impact on the students increasing students motivation to learn.
- As students are more interested in the digital world, it is a better option to include multimedia materials as a part of education system to make education fruitful and productive
- As it has been said that images are thousand times more effective than words using multimedia helps to retain the topic long after that has been taught.

- The use of multimedia enhances the thinking capabilities of the students and helps to grasp the content easily.
- overhead projectors, online discussions, audio video instruments like recorders, tapes, cd players for listening activities makes the learning process easy as it includes pictorial elements that catch their attention. Students enjoyed more when audio was used for listening comprehension.

5. How Should Teachers and Students Use Multimedia in Language Learning and Teaching?

Teachers play a vital role in teaching process and at the same time in successful integration of technology in the classroom. For these teachers:

- Need to have a thorough knowledge of how to use technical instruments because many a time if the teacher is not having adequate knowledge about technology and how it is used it leads to waste of time.
- The teacher should not completely depend upon the multimedia for teaching. Many a times the teacher completely depends upon the PowerPoint presentations that s/he has prepared and when the PowerPoint fails to work because of some technical problem the teacher finds it difficult to teach.
- The teachers should encourage the students to use technology or multimedia for preparing assignments and projects.
- Teacher should combine multimedia and chalk and talk method rather than solely relying on multimedia for teaching purpose.
- Language learning through online practices should be incorporated.
- Blogs should be used to deliver the content related to several topic included in the curriculum.

6. Conclusion

The fact that technology has changed the educational scenario cannot be ignored and therefore has to be accepted. Technology has not only made the learning and teaching process interesting but also it has made the process learner centered. The use of multimedia has motivated the students to learn and participate actively in the language learning.
