5. Methodology of the Study

5.1 Sample

The sample was selected from two schools of urban area and same way two another Schools were selected from rural area by using the random sampling technique. Among these Schools from each area; one School has been taken self financial and another Govt. School has been taken. In this way, by using same sampling technique total 20-20 students (10 male and 10 female students) from each Schools were selected. Therefore, total 80 students were selected from all Schools.

5.2 Tool

Five point opinion scale was prepared by researcher, which contains 30^{th} statements; among 30^{th} statements, 17^{th} statements ware positive & other 13 statements were negative statements to know the

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level of Opinion about availability, usability and requirements of upper Deimers School library in self financed and Govt. Schools. The range of marks was 0 to 120. Out of 120 marks, which got below 60 marks, they considered as unfavorable opinion towards availability, usability and requirements of upper Deimers School library in self financed and Govt. Schools and who got 60 or more then 60 marks, they considered as a favorable attitude towards availability, usability and requirements of upper Deimers School library in self financed and Govt. Schools.

5.3 Statistical Calculations

Statistical parameters like mean, medium, standard deviation (S.D.) t-test were calculated for testing the hypothesis. The calculated data is mentioned in the table no.2.
