



# A Comparative Study on Management of Academic Libraries of Gujarat University Academic Libraries With Reference to Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University Academic Libraries

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## Abstract:

*This study sought to compare management of academic libraries in Gujarat University Academic Libraries and Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University Academic Libraries. A sample of 57 college librarian was randomly selected for the study. Instrument of data collection was a 50 item questionnaire. The college librarians have to play multiple roles for functioning and smooth running of library. How the college librarians working in the affiliated colleges of GU & HNGU manage the problems arising due to management usage is studied and find out the problems among them. I find some lack of support and resources from top management or library authorities, implementation without planning, lack of thinking about self-supporting approach, lack of technology transfer, and incomplete exploration of available options for management and its assessment, lack of requisite level of management skills in library personnel, lack of basic knowledge and insufficient manpower are the main causes in this article.*

Both Universities colleges provide services and facilities for the related literature such as commerce and arts subjects. Overall user of both the Universities affiliated colleges are satisfied with their library services and collection

However the college library is a place where knowledge is collected and communicated. In the present time a revolutionary change with the technology and occurred. There libraries provides collection and services to their users so that every students provides maximum contribution for development. The survey clearly reveals that the librarians of the library wants that the modern collection management & techniques and service should be such that every user can be utilize library collection and services to maximum level. Universities colleges want some improvement in the libraries for the most successful utilization of library collection.

## 2. Purpose of the Study

1. To draw a landscape of college library resources available in affiliated colleges of both the universities.
2. To study the higher education provided by the colleges under the research area.
3. To evaluate and compare current organizational structure of college libraries of both university.
4. To investigate in which areas of library organization follow the principles of library management and make a comparative study.
5. To compare the role of college library committee in colleges affiliated to Gujarat University and Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University.
6. To compare the college library policy in the colleges affiliated to Gujarat University and Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University.
7. To determine the managerial functions like planning, organising, staffing, leading and controlling among the college libraries.
8. To ascertain the library and information services provided by college libraries in the research area.
9. To study the problems faced by college librarians in managing the library.

## 3. Hypothesis

Hypothesis is guessing or assumption and presumption towards a particular situation under certain some conditions in a prescribed time period. It is on previously established relationship between two variables may be dependent and independent. It is a tentative generalization statement which is yet to be proved. The results trace out from previous study or some derived standards are considered as a base to formulate the hypothesis. Good and Scats say that “hypothesis is shrewd guess or inference that is formulated and provisionally adopted to explain observed facts or contortion to guide in further investigation.” Considering the importance of hypothesis is here investigator has formulated hypothesis on theoretical reading, review of literature and several case study.

## 4. Sampling Methods and Data Collection

A field of inquiry constitutes a population or universe, when all items are inquired, items are known as census inquiry. It is not possible many times to inquire all items as it consume more time, energy and cost for data collection. When the census is large in terms of time, manpower and cost involved in data collection, the representative sample is studied, the representative sample is known as sample survey and selection procedure is known as sampling technique or sampling method.

## 6. Suggestions

The suggestions are concern to various authorities and various questions of higher education so researcher has presented the suggestions accordingly concerned authorities.

- The library authority like library committee should be critically reviewed, tested and evaluated after implementation of management technique in the library. The library authority must support management in the library innovation significantly by augmenting individual or group capabilities though motivation support, resource support and information support.
- The college librarians should consult the library committee, the principal and a chief or its representative of top management to solve the problems with imaginable solution, if he/she penalized it.

- The library & information science, professional association/organization/academic staff colleges should organization training programme for advanced management in LIS professionals.
- All colleges are recognized by UGC under section 2(f) and/or 12(B) of UGC Act but some are receive the UGC grant. The principal and organizers of such colleges must try to get UGC grant.
- The principal should give opportunities to the librarian to organize or attend various activities and library orientation, Information literacy programmes for users.
- The government should allocate sufficient budget for the purchase of information resources, infrastructure development and maintenance.
- The photocopying is an important service in the library so recommended photocopying machine must be in the library.
- The atmosphere of the library of both Universities should be atmosphere is according to the students.
- In the colleges of both universities the collection of books should be increased for the students.
- The Library collection and service should be increased in both of libraries or using computerization for the students is very necessary in College library.
- Both college libraries should be appointed well qualified and experienced staff for providing better services to their students.

The college librarian act as information supervisor its post in predictable in the library but state government has stopped the recruitment since 1998, hence 50%+ grant in aided college don't have librarian. This is serious cause of intellectual loss to academic environment in the college. The state government should direct give authorization to the colleges for the recruitment librarian in the colleges. The state government and university should develop the standards and norms for the minimum requirement of the information resources, infrastructure and HRD infrastructure for the college library in the state.

## 7. Conclusion

To overcome these problems a long term and short term strategies have to apply by concern authorities, government and university. It is clear fact that management in the College libraries increasing importance and has fast momentum in developing countries like India. One has to commit for college library development. The librarian's nature for collaboration, cooperation, coordination at all level and personal desire to do new advanced activities will sure bring attachment of produce. The whole hearted support from library committee and principal will make Librarian job stress-free and charming and positive role of college librarian, government, and university will not only enhance the library service but also will establish and build up the strong educational system in the country.

The result obtained in this study revealed that as awesome majority for the librarians depend on the library users were satisfied with the collection services and facilities provided by the college library. But a major difference in both the colleges is that majority of the librarians are unknown about automation.
