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Brief Profile of Dr. N.K.Gupta

Dr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Professor, Educational Research, NCERT did his Master's Degree in Chemistry in first division with Master's, M Phil and PhD in Education as a topper from Jamia Millia Islamia. Started the career as a School Teacher, has been in the teacher education institutions since 1989.

Taught at RIE Ajmer followed by working as Associate Professor and Professor in Educational Research in Department of Educational Research and policy Perspective now known as Division of Educational Research in NCERT. During the tenure as a teacher educator in last 28 years, have written several papers on teacher education, elementary education and researches. Also worked with IGNOU as a Programme Officer, DPEP for more than a year and did try lot of interventions in distance education programme at elementary level. Has conducted several researches at elementary level including the researches on slums of Kanpur, night schools of Chandigarh, Survey of Rajasthan Schools etc. Has visited almost every state of India and have conducted nearly 100 trainings/capacity building programmes on Research and Action Research. Has written book on Action Research, models of teaching and modules of IGNOU, Kashmir University etc.

Has been a member of several research and other academic bodies including the member of Board of Studies of Kadi University Gandhi Nagar, Gujarat, Research Support Groups and advisory Groups of different states like Delhi, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Bihar etc. Also member of Educational Boards of some research journals. Has visited more than 100 schools of the country in different states and member of several advisory bodies for research. Has also worked as Head of the Publication department of NCERT and has been working as Controller of examination for NCERT where he has conducted a prestigious examination of more than

1,76000 aspirants for the aspirants of LDC post in different constituents of NCERT. Is also a member of the Editorial Boards of several journal in India. Has also guided several scholars in Research work including M Ed, M Phil and PhD students. Is on the panel for the evaluation of MPhil and Ph D thesis and the paper setter for different examinations. As a part of the joint working group on education on behalf of Govt of India, visited Afghanistan during 17-22 July 2007 and prepared a plan of action for development of curriculum of Afghanistan at secondary stage Worked as member of the Screening Committees of various institutions/universities and also member of selection committees of different institutions.
