The researcher has conducted person interviews of some of the handicapped girls. Also group interviews are conducted.

The researcher has interpreted the responses given by respondents i.e. physical handicapped girls, blind & deaf, dumb girls, teachers, supervisors, trustee, received through questionnaire and interviews. The researcher has drawn conclusions through this research and made recommendations accordingly.

- 1. In 1991 there were no facilities available for disable handicap girls in and around Hajipur village.
- 2. First of all, in 1991 on world women's day with local villager's opposition Manthan was inaugurated.
- 3. With transparent and good noble progressive work of Manthan Management donors donate too much for handicap girls. All the money is 100% tax free.
- 4. All disabled girls gets equal right of education, right to live and be self confident, with that motto Manthan was started.
- 5. With small but it was started and now with full facility and all type of activities are conducted in Manthan.
- 6. All the staff, Management trustee are working 24 x 7 for this handicap girls.
- 7. To satisfy all the mottos of Manthan, to manage all activities and to discuss all if's and but's managing staff conduct 4 to 5 meetings in a year.
- 8. With Manthan School it was started and now training centre, training service, hostel facility, vocational training centre, physiotherapy centre etc service is also developed.
- 9. Here, Manthan also provide transportation for girls to complete their college education.
- 10.Montthan also have old-age home, Gau Shala.
- 11.Manthan has good reputation in a society for their noble work.
